## Start of School Year 2019

We're back!!! Wow, time flies. This edition of the newsletter will give you important dates for the coming month for both the Elementary and Jr/Sr High.

**IMPORTANT** - please note that Cresson and the Jr/Sr High have **DIFFERENT** start dates for students. This change will better align our primary school schedule with the educational hourly requirements outlined by the Colorado Department of Education. It will also better meet the needs of families in that students at the Jr/Sr High will not need to attend school on Friday of the first week of school. Please note, though, that both schools last day of school for students is the same date.

### School-Based Health Center

The CCV Mountain Health Center wants to get your children's back to school well-child check completed before school. This physical includes athletic physicals and most insurances cover it 100%. Your child's health care plan for asthma, allergies, seizures, and general health conditions can also be completed at. Please call 719-776-4310 to schedule your appointment with Ali Bullis, Family Nurse Practitioner today. A yearly registration form must be filled out, **a parent must be present for the first appointment, and then students can be seen for the remainder of the year without a parent being present.** For children who need immunizations, please call Teller County Public Health at (719) 687-6416 to schedule directly with them. They have a satellite office at the CCV Mountain Health Center, so shots can be performed on-site.
