TEMPERATURE AND SYMPTOMS SCREENINGS

ALL STAFF, STUDENTS, AND VISITORS WILL BE SCREENED AT SCHOOL ENTRANCES FOR:

*TEMPERATURE OF 100.4 OR HIGHER

*SYMPTOMS - COUGH, CHILLS, SHORTNESS OF BREATH, MUSCLE PAIN, SORE THROAT, LOSS OF SENSE OF SMELL OR TASTE, DIARRHEA, NAUSEA, VOMITING



IF SYMPTOMS OR FEVER ARE PRESENT


ANY STAFF, STUDENT, OR VISITOR WITH FEVER OR SYMPTOMS -

1. ISOLATION FROM OTHERS
2. SEND HOME
3. SEE DOCTOR FOR DIAGNOSIS

IF POSITIVE FOR COVID:


4. STAY HOME
 - a. STAY HOME AT LEAST 10 DAYS SINCE SYMPTOMS FIRST APPEARED & NO FEVER FOR AT LEAST 3 DAYS W/O MEDICATION AND IMPROVEMENT OF SYMPTOMS
 - b. SIBLINGS AND HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS SHOULD STAY HOME 14 DAYS
5. **DOCTOR'S NOTE MUST BE PROVIDED TO RETURN TO SCHOOL**

SYMPTOMS AND/OR FEVER BUT **NOT** COVID

1. **DOCTOR'S NOTE MUST BE PROVIDED BEFORE RETURNING TO SCHOOL**
 2. STAY HOME UNTIL SYMPTOMS HAVE IMPROVED
 3. STAY HOME UNTIL FEVER IS REDUCED FOR THREE DAYS WITHOUT FEVER REDUCING MEDICATION
 4. SIBLINGS AND FAMILY MEMBERS **DO NOT** NEED TO STAY HOME

IN-PERSON LEARNING

DURING THE SCHOOL DAY:

1. **ALL** STAFF & STUDENTS WILL BE SCREENED UPON ENTRY
 2. **ALL** STAFF & APPROPRIATELY AGED CHILDREN WILL WEAR MASKS WHILE CLOSE TO OTHERS - ONE MASK WILL BE PROVIDED BY SCHOOL
 3. STUDENTS WILL REMAIN IN COHORTS (WITH CLASSMATES; LIMITED INTERMINGLING WITH OTHERS DURING SCHOOL DAY)
 4. SOCIAL DISTANCING WILL BE IN EFFECT IN ALL AREAS OF THE SCHOOL
 5. EXTRA CLEANING, HAND WASHING, AND USE OF HAND SANITIZER WILL BE IN EFFECT

ONLINE LEARNING

IF YOUR STUDENT OR FAMILY HAS EXISTING HEALTH CONCERNS OR IF YOU WERE SUCCESSFUL WITH ONLINE LEARNING IN THE PAST -

1. NOTIFY YOUR CHILD'S PRINCIPAL TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT

2. ***DISTRICT WILL PROVIDE DEVICES***

BUS TRANSPORTATION

IF YOUR CHILD WILL RIDE THE BUS -

1. COMPLETE BUS REGISTRATION FORM
2. SIGN AGREEMENT

SAFETY MEASURES FOR ALL BUS RIDERS:

MASKS ARE REQUIRED

ONE STUDENT PER SEAT - SIBLINGS MUST SIT TOGETHER

WINDOWS WILL BE CRACKED TO ALLOW FOR AIR FLOW

USE OF HAND SANITIZER WHEN GETTING ON BUS

ALL BUSES WILL BE
CLEANED/SANITIZED AFTER
EVERY ROUTE




PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES - IN-PERSON LEARNING

SCREEN YOUR CHILD(REN) FOR TEMPERATURE/SYMPTOMS DAILY **BEFORE**
SENDING TO SCHOOL

DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD(REN) TO SCHOOL IF SYMPTOMS AND/OR FEVER IS
PRESENT

COMMIT TO FOLLOWING SCHOOL AND BUS SAFETY MEASURES

CONTACT SCHOOL IMMEDIATELY IF YOUR CHILD(REN) OR FAMILY MEMBERS
HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO COVID-19



PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES - ONLINE LEARNING

CONTACT BUILDING PRINCIPAL **BEFORE AUG. 7th** TO SCHEDULE AN
APPOINTMENT

COMMIT TO FOLLOWING ONLINE LEARNING EXPECTATIONS (WILL BE
DISCUSSED DURING MEETING WITH PRINCIPAL)

SIGN ONLINE LEARNING & TECHNOLOGY AGREEMENTS

*IF YOU CHOOSE NOT TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT - YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE
ISSUED A DEVICE*

BE PREPARED TO PROVIDE VALID REASONING FOR CHOOSING ONLINE
LEARNING

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. **WHEN DOES SCHOOL START?** *SCHOOL WILL BEGIN ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 19TH*
2. **WHERE CAN I FIND SCHOOL SUPPLY LISTS?** *CRESSON SCHOOL SUPPLY LISTS - WWW.CCVSDS.COM*
3. **WILL SOCIAL DISTANCING BE REQUIRED?** *YES, TO THE BEST OF OUR ABILITIES*
4. **WILL MASKS BE REQUIRED?** *YES, MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ALL STAFF, STUDENTS, AND VISITORS IN BUILDINGS AND ON THE BUS. THERE WILL BE TIMES THROUGHOUT THE DAY WHEN MASKS CAN BE REMOVED - EATING, SOCIAL DISTANCING, ETC.*

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS, CONT.

5. WHAT IF I DON'T WANT MY CHILD TO WEAR A MASK? *WE UNDERSTAND THERE ARE MIXED VIEWS ON WEARING MASKS. HOWEVER, WE KNOW THAT MASKS HELP PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 WHICH IS WHY WE ARE REQUIRING THEM WHEN STUDENTS/STAFF/VISITORS ARE IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO OTHERS. IF YOU DO NOT WANT YOUR CHILD TO WEAR A MASK OR IF THERE ARE HEALTH REASONS WHY YOUR CHILD SHOULD NOT WEAR A MASK, ONLINE LEARNING MAY BE A BETTER OPTION.*



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS, CONT.

6. WHAT IF SOMEONE TESTS POSITIVE IN MY CHILD'S SCHOOL? IF SOMEONE TESTS POSITIVE, WE WILL MAKE NECESSARY NOTIFICATIONS & IMMEDIATELY CONTACT TELLER COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH & ENVIRONMENT AND FOLLOW THEIR GUIDANCE WHICH MAY INCLUDE QUARANTINE OF A CLASS OR A SCHOOL/DISTRICT CLOSURE.


7. WILL WE RETURN TO REMOTE LEARNING (LEARNING AT HOME)?

MAYBE. IN THE EVENT OF A SCHOOL/DISTRICT CLOSURE DUE TO COVID, WE MAY RETURN TO REMOTE LEARNING UNTIL WE ARE PERMITTED TO RETURN TO IN-PERSON LEARNING.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS, CONT.

8. IF MY CHILD DOES ONLINE LEARNING, CAN HE/SHE ATTEND SPECIALS, INTERVENTION GROUPS, AND/OR PARTICIPATE IN SPORTS? *YES, IF THESE ACTIVITIES ARE BEING OFFERED, ONLINE STUDENTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE. SAFETY MEASURES STILL WILL BE REQUIRED.*

9. WILL THIS PLAN REMAIN IN EFFECT ALL YEAR? *WE WILL MONITOR GUIDANCE FROM THE STATE AND LOCAL AGENCIES TO DETERMINE IF CHANGES TO THE PLAN ARE NECESSARY. WE WILL COMMUNICATE CHANGES AS SOON AS WE KNOW THEM.*
